IMITATION GOLD ROLL

Imitation Gold – Silver Roll

DESCRIPTION:

Very thin leaves made up of pure metals alloy, they are ideal to confer special metalized effects upon every kind of surface. They are mostly used in gilding technique, both traditional and not traditional. The special roll format allows very easy, precise and fast applications in linear decorations.

CARATTERISTICHE CHIMICO/FISICHE:

Appearance:	Rolls of metal leaf
Colour:	conform to labeling
Odour:	odourless
Dimensions:	conform to labeling

USE:

The imitation gold leaf is most often used in non traditional gilding technique, while only the true gold leaf is suitable for the traditional one.

On a proper basecoat and after the application of any Borma Zapon Intermediate Insulator, apply a very thin layer of the suitable Goldsize, only where gilding is needed. When the surface becomes sticky, make the metallic strip adhere and press it with its protective paper.

Where the leaf doesn't adhere perfectly, press it with a cotton bun. Wait for the leaf to be pasted properly, then take away the exceeding pieces of leaf with a soft brush.

Finally apply one hand of Spray Varnish or Zapon Lack.

STORAGE:

Keep the product in a not-ventilated place; keep the container closed when not in use. Keep away from heat, flames, sparks and other sources of ignition.



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PACKAGING:

The product comes in 1cm, 2,5cm, 5cm, 10cm and 15,8cm wide rolls.
